

MIRA MESA ITINERARY

Saturday, November 3, 2007

Call Time: 8:00. Come in your travel uniform with t-shirt and shorts underneath. Wear your marching shoes. Bring a dinner or \$ for dinner. If you did not pay the \$5 for lunch, you will need to bring a lunch as well. Bring a jacket, sweater or sweatshirt for the awards ceremony. Bring all parade and field show equipment.

- 8:10 Parade rehearsal
 - 9:15 Water/snack/bathroom break
 - 9:25 Start loading trailer
 - 9:30 Load large instruments onto trailer
 - 9:50 Load Buses
 - 10:00 Leave Valhalla High School
 - 10:50 Arrive at Mira Mesa H.S. (10510 Reagan Road, San Diego, 92126)
 - 11:00 Change into uniform
 - 11:40 Start mat work
 - 12:00 Full band warm-up/rehearsal
 - 1:30 Stand-by area
 - 1:35 Step off into official warm-up area
 - 1:40 Parade Step Off**
 - 1:45 Arrive back at buses. Change out of uniform (hang uniform carefully for field show). When everything is put away properly, lunch will be served to those who bought Panda Express. Be sure to hydrate yourself during this time (no sodas, etc.) Rest and prepare for the field show.
 - 3:00 Field show stretching and basics block
 - 4:00 Get some water and change into uniform
 - 4:20 Full band warm-up and rehearsal
 - 5:00 Official warm-up time begins
 - 5:15 Move to stadium
 - 5:20 Stand by
 - 5:30 "Valhalla High School, The judges are ready!"**
 - 5:45 Arrive back at buses. Change out of uniform into travel uniform and hang the uniforms carefully. Put all equipment away. Secret sibling bags will be handed out.
 - 6:35 Move to the stadium to watch 5A and 6A bands.
 - 8:30 Leaders go to change. (Drum Major, Color Guard Captain and Lieutenants, Percussion Captain if we have a percussion caption).
 - 8:50 Leaders ready to step out onto field
 - 9:00 Leaders start to go on the field for awards ceremony
 - 9:40 Load the buses
 - 9:50 Depart Mira Mesa H.S.
 - 10:50 Arrive at Valhalla. Unload all equipment, uniforms and instruments. When everything is put away properly, everyone may go home.
