MEMBERSHIP APPLICATION

Each of the following statements has been excerpted from the Bylaws of the Rancho San Diego Music Foundation (RSDMF) adopted August 30, 2007.

OBJECTIVE. The corporation is a nonprofit public benefit corporation and is not organized for the private gain of any person. It is organized under the Nonprofit Public Benefit Corporation Law for public and charitable purposes. The corporation's purpose is to aid, promote and sustain the Valhalla High School instrumental music and color guard programs, by providing financial and other support and assistance to such programs and to the students enrolled in such programs.

VOTING MEMBERS. The corporation shall have a single class of members. Any parent/guardian of a child/dependent student, who is active in the Valhalla High School Instrumental Music and Color Guard program, is eligible for membership. Any such individual may become a member upon the Board of Directors' approval of their membership application . . .

Any student, who is active in the Valhalla High School Instrumental Music and Color Guard program and has attained the age of eighteen years, is eligible for membership . . .

No person may hold more than one membership. Members shall have the right to vote, in the manner set forth in these Bylaws, on the election of directors. In addition, members shall have all rights afforded members under the California Nonprofit Public Benefit Corporation Law.

Membership shall expire on June 30th and may be renewed upon reapplication . . .

There is no fee or donation required to become a member of RSDMF. However, each member is expected to be an active member and to volunteer when they can. Please also consider becoming a sponsor of the Valhalla High School Instrumental Music and Color Guard program.
